

## Curriculum Vitae

Fanny Lichtenstein was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, in 1974. In 1979 she moved to Spain with her family, settling her residence permanently in Barcelona since 1983.

She obtained a bachelor degree in Psychology from the University of Barcelona in 2001, and an advanced degree in *Culture, education and semiotic systems* from doctoral program at the same university. At the same time she worked as a professor at the department of psychology at the University of Barcelona and at the Universitat Oberta de Catalunya.

In 2008 she decided to broaden up her studies at the Institut d'Estudis Fotogràfics de Catalunya (IEFC). Although initially, her interest in photography was purely instrumental to learn how to use a camera it became the heart of her professional life, turning around her trajectory as a teacher and Ph.D studies.

Her last personal projects were made with a estenopeic camera, but she also works with 135mm. camera SLR and 120 SLR.

She has worked for the entertainment industry for the producing company Vagalume, S.L.

In January 2011 she obtained the 3<sup>rd</sup> award *Sin Barreras 2010*, given by COCEMFE-Castilla la Mancha in photojournalism.

In February 2011, she participated in the Conference *Diàleg amb un jove fotògraf* with the renowned catalan poet Joan Margarit, National Poetry Awardee, organized by IEFC.

In May 2011, she participated in the cycle “El Projector. 2<sup>o</sup> cicle de foto-projeccions” organized by Foto Colectania.

In June 2011 is selected for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Award on Photography of Fundació Vila Casas. The photography “*Self-portrait at three spaces*” is exposed until September 2011 in a collective exposition.

In July 2011 she obtained and Honorific Mention in the XI International Award on Photography Arturo Cerdá y Rico.
